Seeka Releases Sustainability Report 2025

Seeka Limited [NZX:SEK] is pleased to present its 2025 Sustainability Report. The report provides an update to stakeholders on Seeka's progress against its environmental, social and governance sustainability goals.

Highlights include:

- 43m trays supplied of highly nutritious NZ kiwifruit, a 44% increase in healthy eating options.
- 3 coolstores upgraded with eco friendly refrigerants, with 800 kgs of high greenhouse gas refrigerants safely destroyed.
- 69 tonnes of kiwifruit donated to NZ Food Network, helping 39 food hubs feed families.
- 2 all-electric all-terrain vehicles operating on Seeka's orchards, testing solutions to decarbonise the orchard fleet.
- 1,011 kW of solar providing power at four facilities, a 22% increase, as Seeka targets 3,000 kW by 2030.

Seeka's 2024 carbon footprint increased to 26,682 tonnes CO₂e, primarily driven by the rebound in NZ kiwifruit yields. Seeka remains committed to lowering its category 1 and 2 direct emissions.
